Appalachian State University - Department of Nursing Learning Improvement Plan

Students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing (BSN) who are not meeting program outcomes, course, and/or clinical objectives may be placed on a Learning Improvement Plan (LIP). The LIP is a communication tool for students and faculty to address areas in need of improvement and will identify the issue(s) of concern with specific examples, related program outcomes, course/ clinical objectives, and an action plan with timelines and measurable criteria for improvement. The LIP is not intended as a punitive measure, rather, it is a means to increase students' success in the nursing program.

Course and clinical faculty will initiate and work with the student to develop the LIP. The course coordinator and program director will be notified when the LIP is issued. A student whose performance does not meet the objectives of the LIP may be subject to course failure or withdrawal from the department of nursing.
